Census 2020

Why do we take the census? The U.S. Constitution mandates a head-count every 10 years of everyone residing in the 50 states, Puerto Rico, and the Island Areas of the United States. This includes people of all ages, races, ethnic groups, citizens, and noncitizens.

Why is the Census important to you?

The population totals from the census determine the number of seats each state has in the House of Representatives. The population totals also affect funding in your community, and data collected in the census help decision makers know how your community is changing.

The U.S. Census Bureau is required by law to protect the information you provide. The bureau is not permitted to publicly release your responses in any way that could identify you. All answers you provide on the survey are confidential.

You are required by law to respond to the Census survey. Every household will have the option of responding online, by mail, or by phone.

You may have already received some information in the mail, or you will soon receive the information. First National Bank is encouraging you to participate in this survey. We will be providing a way to help you complete the survey online. We encourage you to call us if you have questions or need assistance in completing your 2020 Census survey.
