Page 2 Making Memories...

Greece is an absolutely amazing country. Our trip was beautiful from beginning to end. Our adventure began in the ancient city of Athens. Our tour took us to the Temple of Zeus, Parliament, Olympic Stadium and of course, the hill of the Acropolis and the Parthenon. Then it was off to Meteora where we visited two remote monasteries situated in the landscape of limestone rock "towers". These are over 600-year-old Byzantine monasteries. We were fortunate to visit a local studio that creates beautiful Byzantine icons. We visited Delphi, the Sanctuary of Apollo, one of Greece's most important religious centers during Classical times. Our visit took us to Olympia and to the Olympic Stadium where the first Olympic Games were held in 776 B.C. The actual finish line has been unearthed and still remains today. It is truly amazing to see the ruins and hear the stories of how it was found and excavated. Before leaving the mainland for the islands, we visited Mycenae and the Beehive Tombs. We then made our way to Mykonos and Santorini for a few days. Many of us visited the island of Delos (fabled birthplace of Apollo and Artemis. Again, this was so fascinating to see the excavated sites of the ancient city. While in Santorini we visited Akrotiri - the most important prehistoric settlement found anywhere in the Eastern Mediterranean. It is known as the "Minoan Pompeii". The town has been preserved by a volcanic eruption around 1450 B.C. I was so amazed at the ancient wonders of this trip. Of course, we also enjoyed the culture and food of the country as well - olive oil, wines, Mediterranean foods, dancing, etc.

Our movie in May was "Finding Ohana" and Carol Morales was our \$10 drawing winner. The June movie was "Just Like Heaven" and Nancy Bower was the drawing winner.

We had a great group to go to the Fox to see "Beautiful – the Carol King story". We enjoyed a delicious meal at The Melting Pot before the performance. So much more to Carol King's story than I realized. The music and performance was terrific.
