The Cyclorama is a 133 year old hand-painted work of art that stands 49 feet tall, longer than a football field and weighs 10,000 pounds and depicts the Battle of Atlanta in the Civil War. The History Center also has several other exhibits, including "Locomotion - railroads and the making of Atlanta" and "The Bobby Jones Story" and many more.
