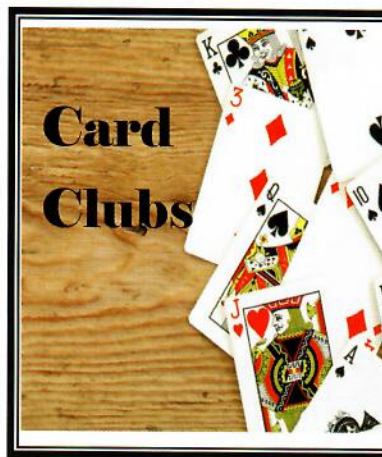

**PLATTE RIVER**

Grand Island, NE  
March 23-27, 2020

In the spring, the Platte River Valley of Nebraska becomes the great gathering place for the Sandhill Cranes. When 600,000 of the majestic cranes flock together, it



is one of the greatest of wildlife spectacles. An estimated 80 to 90 percent of the world's population of Sandhill Cranes makes the trek to this seventy mile strip of the Platte River annually. As we travel to Grand Island we'll stop along the way in Omaha, where we'll have a city tour, tour Offutt AirBase and have lunch at Big Mamas. In Lincoln we'll tour the Capital Building, the International Quilt Museum, and the Larsen Tractor Test Museum. The Crane Trust in Grand Island will be our hosts for a nighttime viewing as well as an early morning blind tour to witness the cranes settling in for the night and setting out in the morning in search of food. Leaving the cranes we'll overnight in St. Joseph, MO including a tour of the Pony Express Museum as we make our way home.

### VIRGINIA BEACH, NORFOLK and the OUTER BANKS of North Carolina.

May 1-5, 2020



Our destination is Norfolk, VA where we'll visit Nauticus, the National Maritime Center and the battleship Wisconsin.

Experience the Parade of Nations from reserved seating, followed by a narrated harbor cruise tour. Then its on to the MacArthur Memorial and an early dinner prior to the tattoo. The Tattoo is



an astounding display of inspirational military music, majestic massed pipes and drums, show-stopping drill teams, and colorful dancers. A full day of exploring Virginia Beach, its' beaches its' unique districts and attractions including the Surf and Rescue Museum and the Military Aviation Museum is included. Then on to the Outer banks of NC where we'll stroll



thru the Elizabethan Garden, a memorial to the lost colony. A visit to Fort Raleigh National Historic Site located on Roanoke Island. Walk around downtown Historic Manteo and explore the Roanoke Marshes Light & the Washington Creef Boat shop and the Bodie Island Lighthouse. Jockey's Ridge State Park is

the home of the tallest natural sand dunes on the East Coast... A visit to the Wright Brothers National Memorial and an interpretative talk about the first flight are included. Depending on flight schedules we will visit Williamsburg, Jamestown and Yorktown either on arrival or before departure.

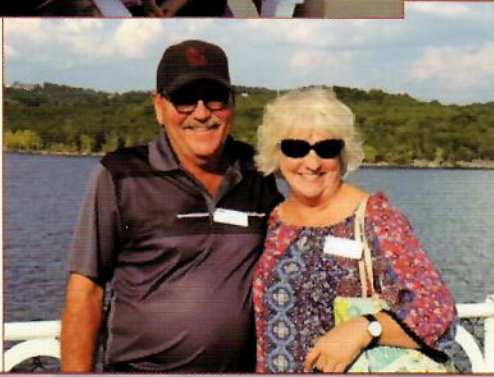

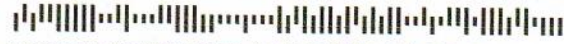
